



## **SATURDAY KNIGHT FEVER 2023**

1. The tournament will be played at Caissa Chess Club\*, 6/F Wing Cheong Commercial Building, 19-25 Jervois Street, Sheung Wan, Hong Kong.
2. The tournament will be played according to the FIDE 'Laws of Chess'. It will be valid for FIDE Rating, so players must have a valid FIDE ID to participate. If you do not have FIDE ID, contact your National Federation.
3. Time Control will be 75 minutes per player plus 15 seconds increment per move. With this rate of play, the tournament will be valid for Standard rating with a rating cap of 2400.
4. The schedule will be as it follows – all games start 7.30pm:
  - Round 1: 7 October
  - Round 2: 14 October
  - Round 3: 21 October
  - Round 4: 4 November
  - Round 5: 11 November
  - Round 6: 18 November
  - Round 7: 25 November
5. Registration can be done at <https://www.caissahk.org/autumn-2023-events> until October 5 or until reaching 40 players, whatever happens first. Entry fee is 450 HKD (350 HKD for Caissa students)
6. The Competition System will be Swiss System, with 7 rounds. For the first round, players must arrive to the playing venue by 7.15 pm, otherwise they will not be included in the pairing even if they have registered. For further dates, players who are unable to play a certain day, should inform the arbiter by the Wednesday before the round. They will not be included in the pairing and will not create any disturbance. Pairings will be published each Thursday. Players who default a game without any notification to the Arbiter will not be paired in future rounds. No half point BYEs will be available at any moment.
7. Recording is mandatory. After the game, both players must write the correct result in the scoresheets, sign them, and submit the original copy to the arbiter. Once signed, the result will stay even if it is not correct.
8. Mobile phones should be switched off in the playing hall, except with arbiter permission.
9. Tie-breaks
  1. Medium Bucholz
  2. Total Bucholz
  3. Sonneborn-Berger.
  4. Armageddon game (White 5 minutes, Black 4, no increment, White must win)

Prizes will be trophies for the top 3 players (top 6 if more than 20 registrations), and for the Best U10, Best U12, Best U16

\* Venue could change to nearby location based on registration numbers
